

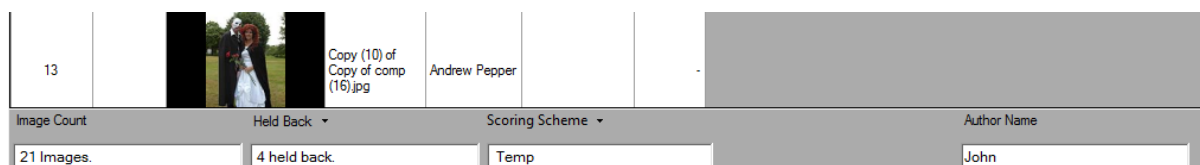
# FILM FREE PROJECTION VERSION 3.1

Version 3.1 has several major changes over version 3.0. The main change is an improvement in the speed of displaying images following a complete rewrite of that area of code. This is particularly noticeable with a large number of images – with 500 images loaded, it is an order of magnitude faster.

Other changes are:

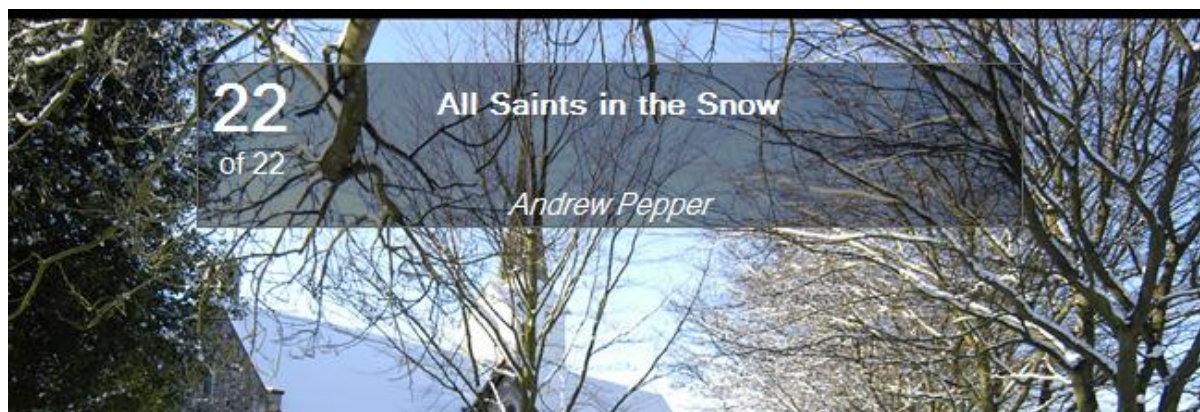
The toolbar at the top of the FFP window has been split into three sub-toolbars: Files, Projection and Competitions. You can now move these sub-toolbars around. You can also select what items appear on each toolbar, so if your club never runs a KnockOut competition, you can remove the options from the toolbar.

The status information at the base of the window has been improved with separate fields for the image count, held back count, scoring scheme and author name:



On the detailed view display, you can now set the font size of the text and change the colours used for showing the various states of rows.

The projection of metadata has been rewritten and now the information is presented on a translucent panel:



A new sort option is available that distributes images so that images by the same author are separated as much as possible.

A new **select...** sub menu is on the **Image** and context menu that allows you to select all the images by the same author, with the same score or with the same subject.

Also on the **Image** and context menus, is an **Insert Blank Every...** option that allows you to insert blank images at regular intervals through the sequence. There is also a new option to remove all blanks.

The project lightbox, facility has been rewritten so that FFP now automatically adjusts the size of the projected images so they fit onto the projected screen.

A new facility when loading folders of images, you can choose to load each subfolder into its own tab.

Speaking of tabs, if using the automatic slide change in continuous mode, you can now choose to automatically go to the next tab so that all images on all tabs get displayed.

The Image Preview window now remembers its previous size and location and returns to those when opened again.

On competition results, you can now specify how equal places are treated. Before version 3.1, if there was a tie for first place (say) the next place would be 2<sup>nd</sup>. You can now choose for the next place to be 3<sup>rd</sup>.
